

- What aspects of digital artistry surprised you the most?
- How do you envision incorporating digital techniques into your own creative pursuits?
- In what ways can digital art contribute to cultural expression and social commentary?
- Did the activity enhance your understanding of digital art's impact on society?
- How might you apply ethical considerations when creating and sharing digital artworks?
